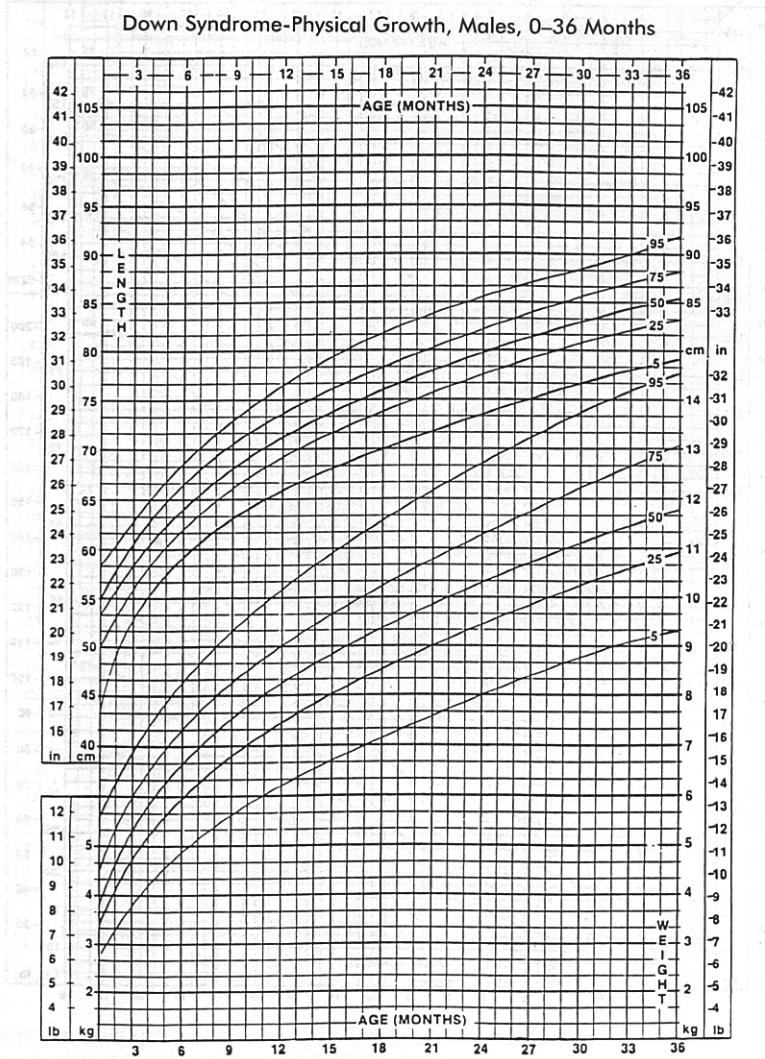
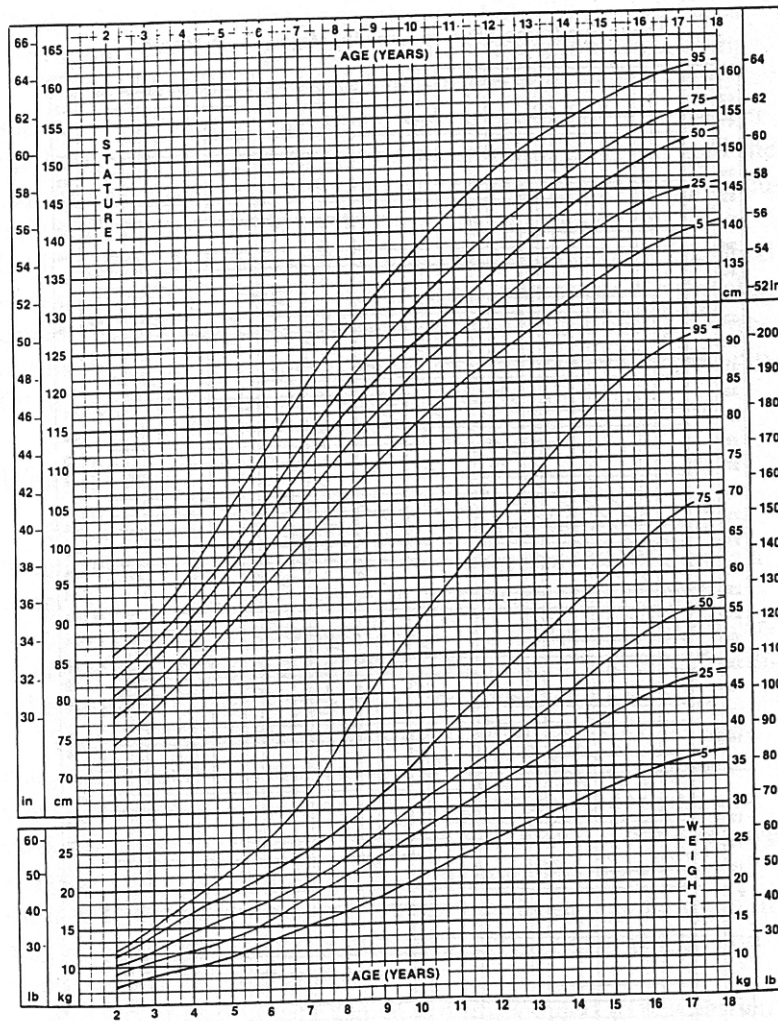


Figure 1. Growth Charts for Boys and Girls with Down Syndrome

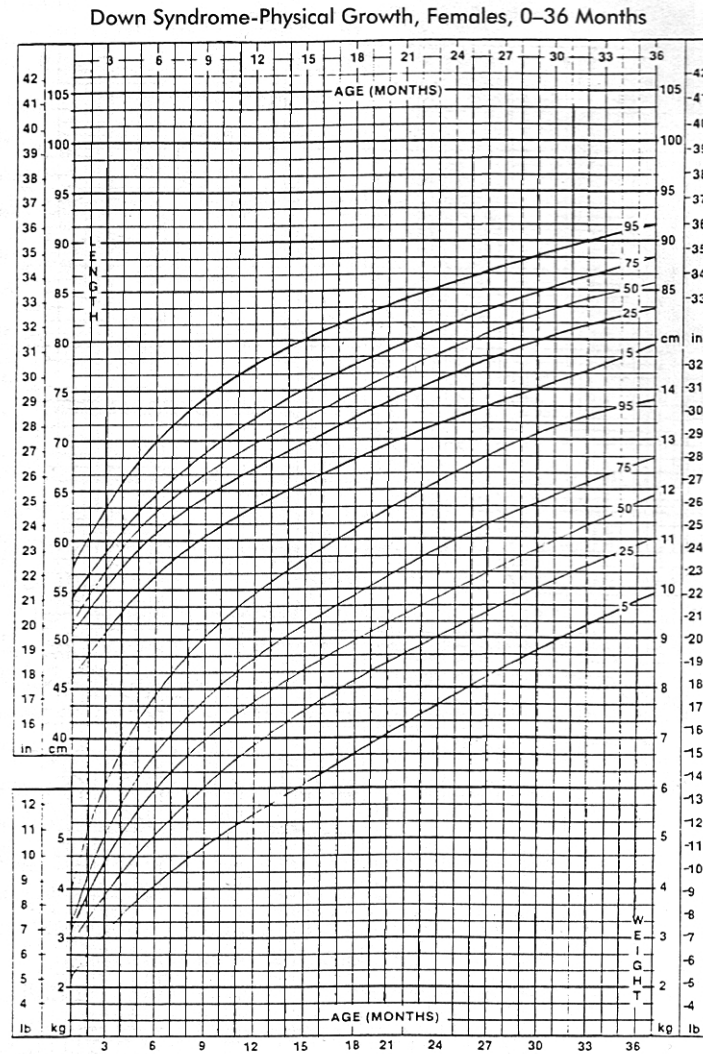

Down Syndrome-Physical Growth, Males, 2-18 Years

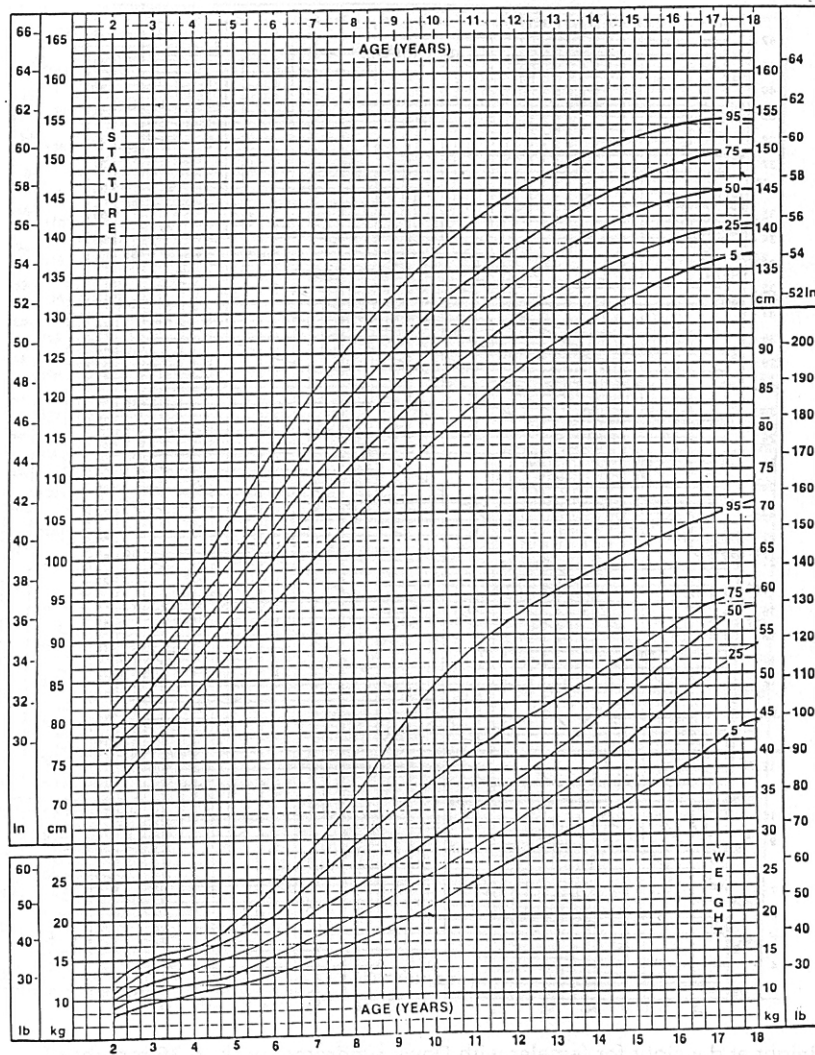


Height and weight for males with Down syndrome 2 to 18 years of age. (Cronk, CE et al: *Pediatrics* 81:102, 1988.)
